

In Absentia Registration Guidelines

This form is for the use of academic graduate students. Students in professional degree programs (M.D., D.V.M., J.D., M.B.A.), please contact your professional school dean's office.

Reduced Fee Level: Students will be assessed the following fees while registered in absentia:

- 15% of Tuition and 15% of the Student Services Fee
- The full UC SHIP health insurance fee, unless you have [waived UC SHIP](#)
- Campus-based fees
- Nonresident tuition, if applicable

Eligibility Criteria for In Absentia Registration: All students pursuing academic doctoral or master's degrees are eligible for In Absentia fee reduction. Students in self-supporting graduate programs are not covered by this policy.

Students may apply for in absentia registration status under the following circumstances:

- Academic doctoral students must have advanced to candidacy by the time the in absentia status would begin
- Master's students must have completed at least three quarters of coursework by the time the in absentia registration would begin
- Special cases within the above two categories can be approved only by exception at the discretion of the Dean of Graduate Studies
- Master's students in self-supporting programs are not eligible
- Students who seek in absentia registration beyond the initial term of in absentia status must reapply for each subsequent year

Enrollment While on In Absentia Registration: Students must be enrolled full-time in an academic doctoral or master's program for the duration of their in absentia registration (299 research or similar independent study units). The research or coursework:

- Must be directly related to the student's degree program as confirmed by UC faculty approval
- Must be of a nature that makes it necessary to be completed outside of the State of California for at least one quarter
- Must involve no significant studying or in-person collaboration with UC faculty during the in absentia period

Time Limits for In Absentia Registration: Academic doctoral students may register In Absentia for up to 6 quarters. Master's students may register In Absentia for up to 3 quarters. Extensions to quarter limits may be reviewed by the Dean of Graduate Studies

Employment and Financial Support: Students are eligible to apply for and receive University fellowships and research assistantships, but not teaching assistantships during the in absentia period.

Students paying the reduced in absentia fee who enroll and pay fees at non-UC institutions will not qualify for additional University of California need-based aid.

Academic Residency: Periods of qualified in absentia registration shall fulfill academic residency requirements for degree programs.

In Absentia Registration Application

In Absentia Reduced Fees: Fees while on In Absentia include – 15% registration fees & student services fees, all campus based fees, UC SHIP health insurance fee, and non-resident tuition (if applicable).

Students may apply for in absentia status if the following criteria are met:

- The research or coursework is of a nature that makes it necessary to be completed outside of California for at least one full quarter
- The work away from the UC Davis is directly related to the student's degree program as evidenced by UC faculty signature
- The work involves only indirect supervision (correspondence or review of written work) from UC faculty during the in absentia period
- The work involves no significant collaboration with UC faculty during the in absentia period. Doctoral students who want to register in absentia for a second academic year must reapply

All applications must be submitted to your Graduate Program Coordinator before the last day of late registration (10th day of instruction) for the term in which in absentia starts. Graduate Coordinators will forward forms to Graduate Studies for review.
