

POLICY REGULATING PROGRAMMATIC CHANGES SUBMITTED
FOR REVIEW BY GRADUATE COUNCIL

Proposed changes to graduate program degree requirements and bylaws must be submitted to Graduate Council for approval prior to implementation. Graduate Council approved the following policy on December 02, 2016, that relates to the period when a graduate program is being reviewed.

While a program is in the “review phase,” Graduate Council will not accept degree requirement or bylaws changes for review. The “review phase” covers the period from the last day in February prior to the program’s self-review submission deadline to the date of Program Review Closure or 6 months after requested final program responses are received by Graduate Council, whatever date comes first.

Before the “review phase,” and after program review initiation letters are sent, degree requirements and/or bylaws changes may be submitted for review and will then be considered a priority item by Council’s Educational Policy/Bylaws Committee. The graduate program must agree to work with the committee to expedite the review and approval process.
