48% GSR III, Academic year	\$14,370
100% GSR III, Summer	<u>\$ 9,980</u>
Total	\$24,350

Graduate Students who have passed PhD Qualifying Exam

48% GSR IV, Academic Year	\$15,520
100% GSR IV, Summer	<u>\$10,780</u>
Total	\$26,300
