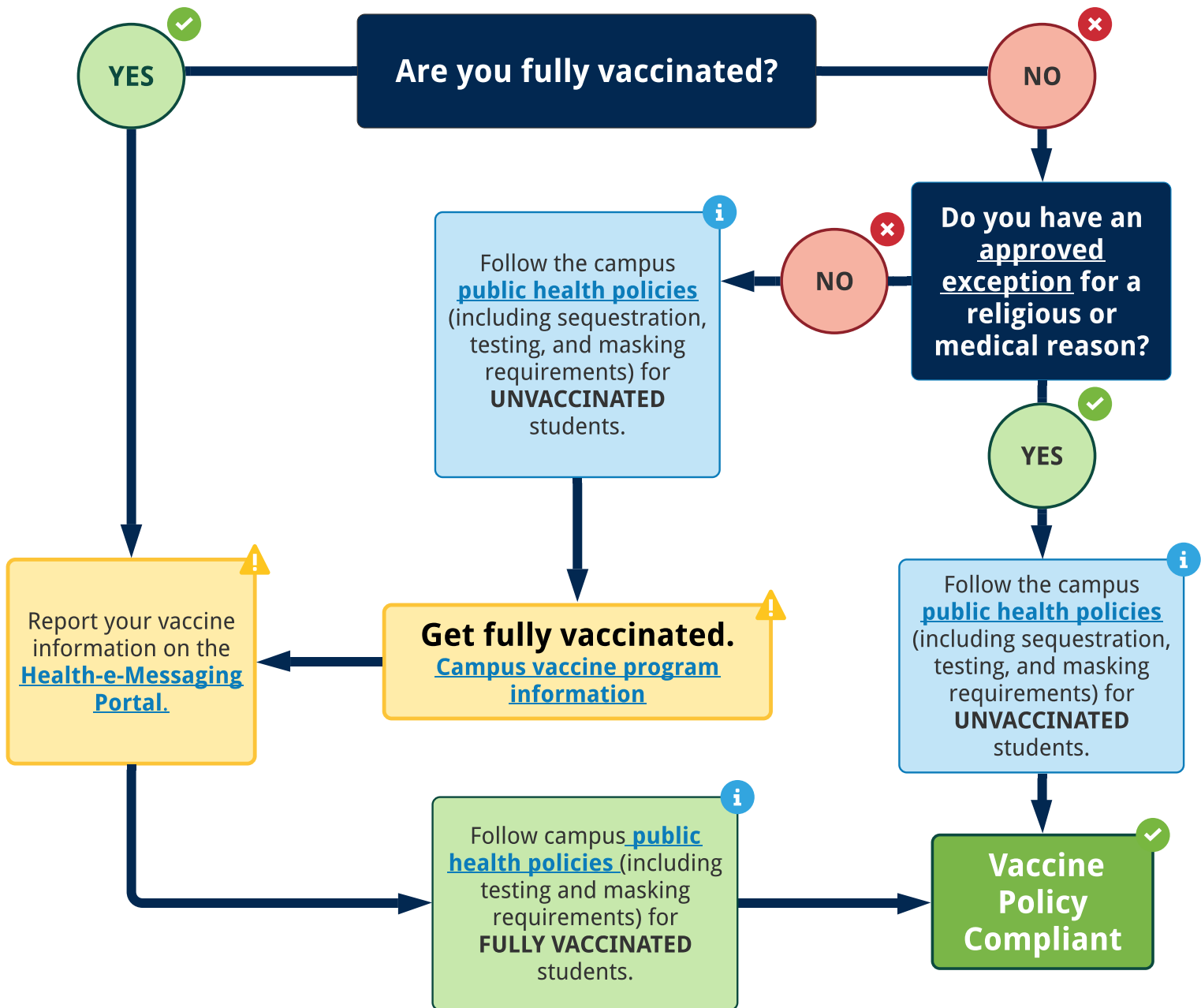

Campus Definitions:

Fully vaccinated: Someone who completed an FDA-licensed or [WHO-authorized](#) COVID-19 vaccination series more than 2 weeks ago. Note: Current WHO-authorized vaccines include: Pfizer, Moderna, Janssen (Johnson & Johnson), AstraZeneca, Covishield, Sinopharm, and Sinovac.

Unvaccinated: Someone who either has not received any FDA-licensed or [WHO-authorized](#) vaccinations against COVID-19, has only had the first shot in a two-part vaccination series, is still in the 2-week waiting period after a final shot, or is out of date getting a booster shot.
