The Graduate Group in Immunology provides competitive compensation for their graduate students. Students will be paid annual stipends in 12 monthly installments of \$2,462.97 within the Graduate Student Researcher (GSR) title. The annual stipend rate is \$29,555.65. The appointment will be structured as a GSR, Step VIII at 46.34%. Graduate Program Fellowship Allocation, awards, fellowships and other generated income can be used to offset the stipend. The GSR title requires that in-state and out-of-state fees be paid at the current rate.
